What's With The Pig?

Manannán mac Lir is a sea deity in Irish mythology. He is the son of Lir (an Irish sea god) and is often seen as a psychopomp (a conductor of souls to the afterworld) with strong affiliations to the Otherworld, the weather, and the mists between the worlds.

According to legend, Manannán had a number of pigs that could be slaughtered and cooked one night, only to reappear in their pen the next day, restored to life and full health. He gifted these pigs to the Tuatha De Danann (the 5th people to settle Ireland) to help them after being displaced as the rulers of Ireland.

In modern folklore it is believed that if a pig is seen with a deformity (such as a bent leg or missing tail) then the pig must be a descendent of Manannán's pigs, and therefore good luck. Look again at the pig on our shield and you will see his ear is missing a little piece. We placed him on our shield to symbolize good luck and strength.

How to Taste - the William Oliver's Way

Ask any expert and they will all agree that whisk(e)y tasting doesn't have to be complicated. However, none of them seem to be in agreement about exactly how to taste whisk(e)y. Below is our method for enjoying whisk(e)y "properly". However, the best advice we ever received came during a Glenfiddich distillery tour: "Drink it however you prefer, so long as you drink it." We don't know everything; however, we have tasted enough whisk(e)y that we feel comfortable giving the following advice:

METHOD: Use a glass that is comfortable in your hand. Make sure the glass is clean. Open up the whisk(e)y by cradling the glass in your hands, causing it to heat slightly. Put one hand around the bottom of the glass and one over the top (to keep the volatiles in). This will release the aromatics. Give it a smell. Move the glass from one side of the nose to the other. Take small, normal, sniffs. If all you can smell is the alcohol, pull it away from your face and try again in a couple seconds. Give it a taste. Hold it in your mouth a little bit. Add some water and give it another taste. Keep adding water until you are happy that you found all the nuances in the whisk(e)y. Once it starts to taste like water you have added too much. Order another one. This time add the amount of water you think is right and try to really pull out all the flavors. Whisk(e)y is complex, it will take more than one sitting to figure it all out.

Note: Not all whisk(e)y will need water added. Typically the better the whisk(e)y the less water it will need.

Kavalan Single Malt

(Taiwan) Fragrant nose with tropical fruits with floral and vanilla notes. There's mango throughout the palate along with spicy barley, gentle oak, and an overall creamy richness. Finishes with a touch of allspice, vanilla, and fragrant pear skin. 80 proof. \$15

Komagatake Single Malt

(Japan) Komagatake translates to Alpine Cherry Blossom and is the second release in the nature series from Mars Shinshu. Both 3-6 year and 25-30 year whiskies compose this exquisite single malt. Floral with subtle notes of leather, an elegant mature peat lingers. 104 proof. \$20

Mikkeller Spirits Black Version O

(Denmark) Small batches of the Mikkeller Black (an imperial stout) are distilled and aged in Oloroso sherry casks. These casks gives the spirit tastes of dark chocolate, dark fruits, and nuts. 90 proof. \$14

Navazos Palazzi Malted Barley

(Spain) ~Limited~ Aged in Palo Cortado sherry casks, only 900 bottles were released. The sweetness and sherry influence is subtle. Sitting amongst the inner Hebridean Scottish Isles, are the malt whisky producing islands of Islay and Skye. Rugged, windswept, and barren, the island landscapes generally produce single malt whiskies with strong peaty and maritime aromas.

Highlands

SMOOTH & FLORAL

Known as one of the most scenic regions in Scotland, this land of rugged peaks and heather covered moor-land is geographically the largest of the whisky-producing regions. It covers two major areas and a variety of warm, rounded single malt whiskies. The West Highlands with its maritime influence and the Central Highlands include heather and honey flavors.

Speyside

DELICATE & FRUITY

The lush, fertile valley of the River Spey - is undoubtedly the heart of single malt whisky distilling in Scotland. It's classic flavors of honey, vanilla, and fresh fruits combine to create whiskies that are both sophisticated and elegant. With age, and especially when matured in sherry casks, they evolve to deliver dried fruit and sweet spice flavors.

Lowlands

LIGHT & FRESH

The lowlands are characterized by rolling fields which are ideally suited to growing grain. The softer landscape is mirrored in the region's single malts which tend to be lighter in both color and body. With little or no peat used in the drying of the malt, the whiskies distilled here are generally fresh and light, fragrant, and floral with cereal flavorings.
